At McFable Farm, we provide a welcoming sanctuary for individuals with special needs and personal challenges, fostering acceptance and empowerment through diverse programs and activities such as gardening, animal interactions, and creative arts. We emphasize the importance of family support, creating opportunities for bonding and shared experiences. We strive to promote healing, joy, and personal growth, inspiring transformative changes that empower everyone to thrive and feel a sense of belonging.

Our Story

McFable Farm is more than just a place; it is a welcoming space where people can connect, share their stories, and find strength in togetherness. Shortly after acquiring the farm, Michelle visited the local hospice care center and recognized that the farm could be more than just a hobby. It had the potential to offer a safe haven for individuals and their families dealing with end-of-life challenges, allowing them to relax and find joy.

With just a few phone calls, along with her lifelong passion for helping others and a commitment to supporting those facing emotional difficulties, Michelle transformed her hobby farm into a care farm. This space would not only serve hospice care patients but also anyone grappling with anxiety, depression, or feelings of hopelessness.

In March 2023, McFable Farm officially became a registered non-profit care farm, dedicated to providing the community with a refuge to set aside their worries for a while and participate in uplifting physical (Leck et al., 2013) and mental (Elings and Hassink, 2008; Iancu et al., 2014) self-care activities.

The transformation was fueled by Michelle's unwavering dedication and the support of like-minded volunteers who shared her vision. Together, they developed a range of programs tailored to meet the diverse needs of their visitors. From animal interactions, where gentle creatures provided comfort and companionship, to hands-on gardening opportunities that offered a peaceful escape, each activity was crafted with care and purpose.

The farm has now become a beacon of hope and healing, attracting individuals and families from all walks of life. Visitors find solace in the tranquil surroundings, where the gentle rustle of leaves and the soft murmur of farm life creates a backdrop for reflection and renewal.

Our Mission: To empower individuals facing anxiety, depression, and feelings of hopelessness by creating a safe, judgement-free environment for support and healing. We provide resources and tools that promote self-awareness, emotional intelligence, and coping strategies, helping individuals not only overcome their current struggles but also cultivate resilience and adaptability.



Farm Friends

We partner with local educators to coordinate on-site visits for special needs classrooms. This provides fresh air and non-traditional learning opportunities along with animal interactions for additional emotional bonding and support

We hold 3-4 admission-free, sensory-friendly events at the farm each year for special needs members of our community and their families.



Community Support

We attend and/or participate in 5-10 community events each year. Past events have included Trunk-or-Treat, Chili Cookoff, Fall Crawl, Paint Madison County, Weekly Chamber Coffees, and the Festival of Lights.

We provide a retreat space for local businesses by opening our farm to company-organized events that provide animal interaction and opportunities for self-care and team building.



Respite & Healing

We partner with special needs organizations, hospice care centers, nursing facilities, and substance abuse support programs to provide a safe environment for these agencies to conduct their therapy sessions outside of an office environment. At the organization's request, we transport animals to their facility.

I am writing to share the impact that our McFable Farm visits have had on the students in our 7-12 special education class. Through our regular scheduled visits to the farm, our students have experienced growth in ways that are difficult to achieve within a traditional classroom setting.

The farm provides a calm, sensory-rich environment where students can connect with nature and animals, allowing them to engage in meaningful, hands-on activities that support their overall development. These visits have proven to be particularly beneficial for our students with special needs, offering them unique opportunities to learn, grow, and thrive.

The key benefits of McFable Farm visits include:

- 1. Enhanced Social-Emotional Development: Working with animals has provided a natural and therapeutic way for students to reduce stress, manage anxiety, and learn empathy. Students practice responsibility and patience while caring for the animals, which translates to improved interpersonal relationships and emotional regulation in their daily lives.
- 2. **Hands-On Learning Experiences**: The Farm setting allows students to apply academic concepts in real-world scenarios. Tasks like planting, caring for animals, and working with farm tools reinforce skills in math, science, and life skills, while engaging students in a way that is particularly effective for those with diverse learning needs.
- 3. **Increased Independence and Confidence:** Many students have shown growth in their independence. By taking on responsibilities at the farm, such as feeding animals, students develop a sense of ownership and pride in their work, which boosts their self-confidence and ability to take on new challenges.
- 4. **Improved Physical and Mental Well-Being:** The physical activity involved in farm work, combined with the calming influence of nature, has contributed to improved mental and physical health among our students. Time spent outdoors provides them with a much-needed break from the classroom environment, helping them return refreshed and focused.

The impact of this program extends beyond the students themselves. The connection between the school and the broader community has been strengthened. By engaging with the farm, our students are developing lifelong skills that promote confidence, responsibility, and emotional well-being.

I am truly grateful for the opportunity to incorporate these farm visits into our special education program. Thank you for your conservation of continued support for this valuable initiative.
